Project Summary:

Where are we building?

- ◆ Broward County, FL
- ◆ State Road 810- Hillsboro Blvd. from Military Trail to Federal Highway.

What are we doing?

- ◆ From Military Trail to NW/SW 2nd Terrace:

- Mill, resurface and some minor widening of Hillsboro Blvd.

- Installing bike lanes in both directions.

- Drainage modifications.

- ◆ From NW/SW 2nd Terrace to SE/NE 2nd Avenue:

- Mill and resurface to improve pavement conditions.

- Median modifications.

- ◆ From SE/NE 2nd Avenue to Federal Highway:

- Construct raised medians with median openings at selected locations.

- Drainage modifications

- Reducing the roadway from 6 lanes to 4 lanes.

- 7 foot bike lane in both directions.

- 7 foot sidewalks including pedestrian accessible ramps.

- Decorative lighting.

- ◆ Upgrading signals to mast arms at Martin Luther King Jr. Avenue, SE/NE 2nd Avenue, and SE/NE 6th Avenue.

When will this happen?

- ◆ Begin construction: Summer 2016
- ◆ Estimated time of construction: 2 years
- ◆ Estimated construction costs: 5.3 million.
