Because it is a single-stream program, residents can throw all of their traditional accepted materials in one container and wheel it to the curb on their collection day. A complete list of approved materials can be found at www.deerfieldbeach.com.



Once residents receive their new carts, they will have the option of keeping their old yellow and blue bins, leaving them curbside for pickup on their recycling day, or bringing them to the city's recycling drop-off center, where they can earn points for turning them in. Returned bins will be recycled.

In addition to the new curbside recycling improvements, the recycling drop-off facility at 401 SW 4 St. will continue to accept a wide array of materials for recycling. Recycling Perks will also provide promotional offers for proper disposal of accepted items at this facility later this year.

Goals of these enhancements are to increase recycling rates, increase the diversion of solid waste from incinerators and landfills, promote local businesses, and improve efficiency and service of the city's recycling operations.

The city of Deerfield Beach boasts one of the highest recycling rates in all of Broward County and anticipates this program will continue to allow the city to be a recycling leader.
